Shower Screen Not Installed Flush with the Inside Edge of the Hob Waiver and Acknowledgment of Risk

Civic Shower Screens and Wardrobes has been requested to install a shower screen that is not flush with the inside edge of the shower hob, contrary to our recommended installation practices and the intent of the applicable Australian Standards (AS 1288 and AS 3740) and National Construction Code (NCC).

While Civic is committed to delivering high-quality workmanship, we must advise that this installation method may increase the risk of water escaping the shower area, product performance issues, and non-compliance with applicable building requirements.

Acknowledgment and Acceptance

By signing this waiver, I acknowledge and accept the following:

- I have been informed that installing a shower screen that is not flush with the inside edge of the shower hob is contrary to Civic's recommended installation practices and not compliant with the requirements of the National Construction Code (NCC) and Australian standards AS 1288 and AS 3740.
- Civic will not issue any compliance documentation or certifications (including Form 15 or Form 16 where applicable) related to this shower screen installation.
- Any warranty relating to leaks, water ingress, product failure, or installation issues will be void as a result of this non-standard installation.
- Civic will not be held liable for any damages, defects, or failures arising from this installation, including but not limited to water damage, mould, or structural deterioration or rectification costs.
- I indemnify Civic for any claims, damages, costs, or liabilities arising from the decision to proceed against Civic's advice and industry standards.
- Civic reserves the right to refuse any future warranty claims, service work, or support relating to this installation.

Compliance Disclaimer

I acknowledge that installing a shower screen that's not flush with the inside edge of the shower hob may not comply with the requirements of the National Construction Code (NCC), AS 1288 (Glass in Buildings - Selection and Installation) and AS 3740 (Waterproofing of Domestic Wet Areas).

I understand that proceeding with this installation may affect building certification, insurance claims, future property sales, and any requirement to demonstrate compliance with applicable Australian building regulations.
